

# 2009 DEPAUL UNIVERSITY SUMMER VOLLEYBALL CAMPS

## High Performance – July 11-12

Grades 9-12 Cost: \$225

This two-day camp is designed to sharpen the skills of the high school aged athlete. All volleyball skills will be covered, including passing, setting, serving, blocking, defense, and attacking. The camp is designed to give athletes individualized skill instruction with an emphasis on position training as well as team training. Student athletes will be broken into groups by ability level (not grade level) and each court will receive step-by-step instruction from the DePaul Volleyball staff.

## Libero/Defense – July 14

6:00 - 9:00 pm

Grades 9-12 Cost: \$45

This is a one-day clinic designed for athletes looking to make an impact on their high school and club teams. We will take time to cover all of the skills necessary to be an effective passer and competitive defender including ball control and footwork.

## Hitting and Setting – July 14

6:00 - 9:00 pm

Grades 9-12 Cost: \$45

This one-day clinic features intense instruction designed for setters and hitters. The first focus will be on individual training to master the skills at either position. Athletes will be divided into groups depending on their ability level. Courts will later be combined for more game-like action.

### Check-In:

Camp check-in is 30 minutes prior to the first session and will take place in the foyer of the Sullivan Athletic Center. Come ready to play with gym shoes and be dressed in athletic apparel. Each athlete will receive a camp t-shirt.



## BLUE DEMON COACHING STAFF



Since Head Coach Amy (Kleyweg) Hardison took over the Blue Demon program in 2006, DePaul has seen marked improvement in the BIG EAST Conference including student-athletes being named Rookie and Player of the Week and Academic All-Stars. Hardison's first recruiting class received highest honorable mention by PrepVolleyball.com in 2006-07. Junior Sarah Cullen was on top of the BIG EAST Conference, ranking second in kills per set, while sophomore Kate Letcher ranked fourth in aces per set.

Previous to joining the Blue Demon staff in February of 2006, Amy spent nine seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Denver where she coordinated all of the Pioneers' recruiting efforts and worked extensively with the team's middle hitters. During Hardison's tenure at Denver, she helped the Pioneers win the school's first Sun Belt West Division Title. Hardison also helped mentor eight All-Sun Belt Conference players as well as the setter and newcomer of the year in 2000.

An outstanding collegiate student-athlete, Hardison helped the University of South Florida to an impressive 78-21 overall record and two trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Prior to his first season with the Blue Demons, Jennings spent a season as an assistant coach at Eastern Kentucky and was the head men's coach at St. Ambrose from 2004-06. At ECU he helped mentor Brittany Nobilio, the NCAA record holder for digs per game and career digs.

Jennings started coaching at St. Ambrose University, where he was the head men's volleyball coach and the head women's junior varsity coach. During his first season, his squad was ranked in the top 10 of the NAIA volleyball poll for six consecutive weeks. While at St. Ambrose, he coached five all-conference selections and the 2005 Newcomer of the Year.

In 2008, Jennings also coached for the USA Athletes International Men's team that competed in the Scottish Open Volleyball Tournament in Perth, Scotland. The team posted a 5-0 record and won the tournament by beating the Scottish National Team in the final match. He is slated to take the same team to compete in Holland in June of 2009.

As an undergraduate at Augustana College, Jennings was a four-year starter and two time captain of the DII club squad. He led Augustana to three National Intramural Recreation Sports Association (NIRSA) top-10 finishes and was named All-Conference as well as the team MVP as a senior.

Nichole Stahovich in her first year as the Graduate Assistant Coach for the DePaul Blue Demons.

In only a short three year career at UW-Stevens Point, Stahovich led the Pointers as an outside and middle hitter. She is currently in the Pointer record books for career aces, career kills, career digs, season aces per game, and season kills per game.

Nichole has worked with multiple levels of athletes. Her latest stint was as a volunteer at UW-Milwaukee and as a head coach for Milwaukee Sting volleyball club. She has also worked for UW-Platteville as a volunteer for their men's club and has worked miscellaneous camps for many schools including Ohio State and Wisconsin.
